From Interstate 80:

Exit 210A (15 South) to the New Columbia exit. Take the New Columbia exit off of Rt. 15. Turn **right** at the stop sign. Go 1 1/2 miles to Grey Hill Road. Turn **right** onto Grey Hill Road. Go 1 1/2 miles to Number 10 Road. Turn **right** onto Number 10 Road, go 1/10 mile to Buck Road. Turn **right** onto Buck Road and follow into the campground. *(Watch for signs.)*
